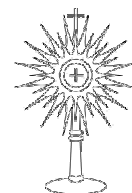

Theme Sharing



Baptism of the Lord

Why was Jesus baptized? Surely, not for the forgiveness of sins. Rather, by his baptism Jesus identifies with us; he takes on our shortcomings. Through his baptism, we identify with Jesus: the words spoken by God about Jesus, "You are my Son, the Beloved: with you I am well pleased," are spoken about us as well.

To know that, like Jesus, we are beloved of God is both awesome and somewhat frightening. What do we fear? Perhaps our fear is our inability to accept that the light of God shines within each of us. God's affirmation of Jesus signals what the mission of Jesus is about. It is a mission which welcomes everyone without preconditions. Somewhere along the way, our experience might have taught us that we had to prove ourselves to parents, family, friends or colleagues. We may be thinking we also have to prove ourselves to God. Not so! God loves us because we are God's sons and daughters — indeed, heirs, as Paul tells us in the second reading.

In today's Eucharist, God once again affirms his unconditional love for us. We have the opportunity to respond to God's love. Receiving the Eucharist dispels the fears we may have and gives us the courage to let our light shine, reaching out to others so that they too may know that they are beloved of God.

Pope's January prayer intention: For youth to follow Mary's example

Pope Francis on Tuesday released a video message accompanying his prayer intention for January, which this month is "For young people to follow the example of Mary".

In his prayer intention for the month of January 2019, Pope Francis says: "Let us pray that young people, especially in Latin America, follow the example of Mary and respond to the call of the Lord to communicate the joy of the Gospel to the world." It has become the custom of Pope Francis to release a video message detailing his prayer intention for each month.

The full text of his intention is below:

You young people have, in the Virgin Mary, a reason for joy and a source

Take advantage of the World Youth Day in Panama to contemplate Christ together with Mary. We will pray the Rosary together for peace, each of us in our own language.

And ask for strength to dream and to work for peace.

Let us pray that young people, especially in Latin America, follow the example of Mary and respond to the call of the Lord to communicate the joy of the Gospel to the world.

Catholic Art

宗教藝術

I believe that when people study Catholic art and its history, they become closer to the church on an intellectual and cultural level that greatly enhances their relationship with God. Church played an important role in the development of Western art. Investigating that role in a study of art history, from medieval to modern times, enhances spiritual and intellectual enlightenment. Art and its history help people to understand the mechanisms of culture and society.

Art and religious expression go hand-in-hand, and the importance of art to convey spirituality is ancient. It has existed since the dawn of civilization.

How wonderful it is for a Catholic to view religious works of art from any century and gain both spiritual and intellectual reward. When studying the course of art history, they will also understand the shift in the church's attitude towards art and aesthetic representation as the Middle Ages drew to an end with the dawning of the Renaissance.

Knowledge about art is highly rewarding and a lifelong experience. As well, it helps us enjoy and appreciate the God-given talents and gifts of others. The study will enhance one's inner, personal experience of faith, and foster a greater understanding of Christ's teachings.

當研究天主教藝術及其歷史時，我們會在知識和文化上更加接近教會，從而增強與上主的關係。教會在西方藝術的發展中起了重要作用，從研究中世紀到現代的藝術，可以加強我們靈性和知識上的啟發。

藝術和宗教是相輔相成的，藝術傳達靈性的重要性是自文明開始以來就已經存在。

觀看任何一個世紀宗教藝術作品，從而獲得靈性上回報是一件奇妙的事情。研究藝術史從文藝復興時期到中世紀即將結束時，他們會了解教會對藝術和審美態度的轉變。

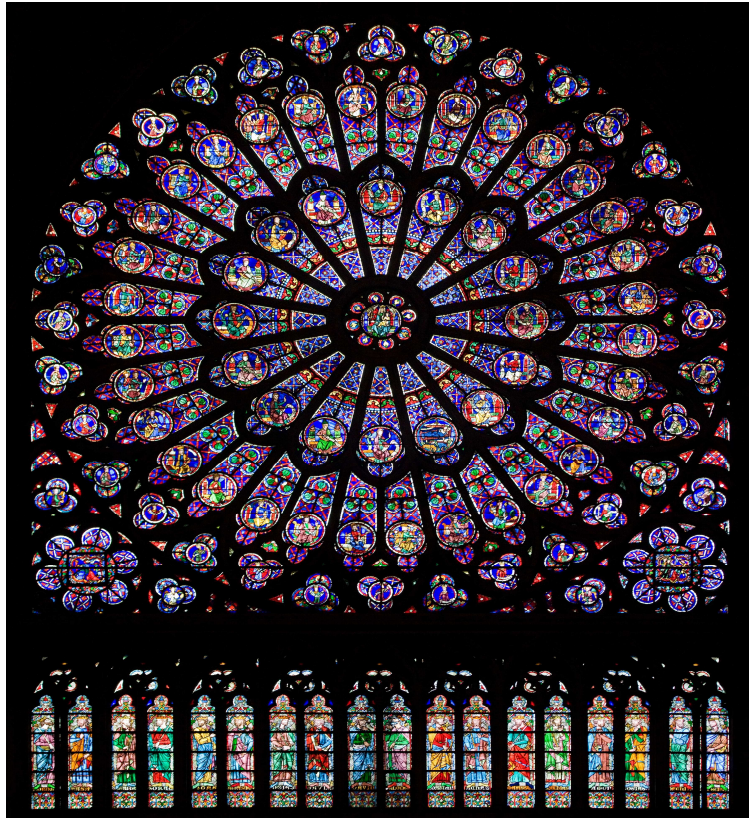
了解藝術有助於我們欣賞上主賜予人類的才能，以及宗教藝術家們各按自己的文化、社會、神修背景去試著繪畫天主的肖像。宗教藝術以人的語言述說神，不可見的神。這不是一般藝術家能把握的，唯有生活「在父懷裡」，與「那獨生者」緊緊結合的藝術家，能為世人詳述。

六世紀初倪狄奧尼修斯書的作者認為：「天主本身是不可理解，不可言說，但透過可感的象徵，人可以反思神聖奧蹟的層面，從而明白上主，洞悉上主。」八世紀初神學家大馬士革的若望把形象稱作為「無字的書」，他認為聖像有著不可言喻的神秘作用，我們可以建立上主的可感形象，把視覺聖化，透過它我們在精神上與天主結合。

上主既然沒有任何具體形像和特質，人們便以光賦予上主可感的存在：「那普照每人的真光，正在進入這世界。」（若 1:9）。倪狄奧尼修斯書的作者認為：「上主可被形容為光。任何受造物，無論可見或不可見的，都是祂所造就的一束光。」

就以哥德式藝術為例，教堂裡的鑲嵌畫、工藝品、玻璃彩畫、書籍裝幀、抄本彩飾畫，可見中世紀藝術家借助光的透射，顯現了作品的色彩，表現了天主的絕對美和神奇的力量。在宗教藝術中，因為光而現的色彩也有象徵功能，例如：金色象徵天主、紅色象徵天主的愛情與耶穌的犧牲。

主日分享



主受洗節

在常年期的主日感恩禮中，教會把耶穌公開生活中發生的事蹟，一幕一幕地呈現在我們眼前，也一段一段地將祂的宣講播送到我們耳中。這不但引導教會自己信仰基督，也促使她反思，並更深地認識自己的生命。正如教宗保祿六世說的：基督是教會的一面鏡子；在基督身上，教會了解自己。

我們在禮儀中所處身的團體便是教會；耶穌基督臨在於主日福音中，讓我們在祂身上，對教會有更深的認識。那麼，今天記述耶穌受洗的福音，又帶給我們什麼啟示呢？

耶穌在約旦河受洗，是祂公開傳播福音的開始，人類救恩的根源也在此時顯露出來。耶穌受洗之後，天上有聲音說：「這是我的愛子，我因祂而喜悅。」這顯然是來自天主聖父的話語。救恩最終的根源是天主聖父，祂永恆的計畫便是提拔人類分享天主的生命；即使人類有罪，仍要施以救援，使他們不失成為天主子女的恩惠。這個計畫由降生成人的天主聖子完成，所以當耶穌公開生活之始，在人群中受洗時，天主聖父表達祂的喜悅，因為愛子耶穌將要以祂的死亡及復活來實現救恩計畫。耶穌整個救援工程，是在聖神的能力中進展，所以在主受洗時，聖神藉著鴿子的形象降在祂上邊。如此看來，人類救恩的根源是天主聖三。

梵二大公會議，稱教會是天主救恩的聖事，這是說天主的救恩臨在教會成員身上，使他們享有天主子女的生命，同時教會還將天主的救恩傳遍全人類。讀了今天耶穌受洗的福音，我們一定會聯想到教會的根源。既然天主聖三是救恩的根源，教會又是救恩的聖事，那麼它的根源，當然是天主聖三了。

天主在基督內創造及救援的恩惠，自始便賜與人類，不過在人類歷史的進展中，祂揀了以色列民族作為救恩的標記。這並不是說其他民族不蒙受天主的恩惠，而是說在以色列民族的歷史中，天主以言以行證實祂的救恩。故以色列民族稱為天主的子民，蒙受召選，便是要透過他們遵守盟約的生活，來為天主的創造及救援工程作證；但實際上舊約天主子民並沒有充分完成自己的使命，於是耶穌基督被派遣，決定性地實現天主聖父的計畫，並由祂建立一個團體，那便是教會。教會是救恩的聖事，這並不是說教會之外沒有天主的創造與救援的恩惠，而是說她應當作為一個活生生的標記，宣揚天主的救恩真實地臨在人間，並為此作證；故教會也稱為新約天主子民。教會作為救恩聖事的最後根源是天主聖父，不過，除非教會與耶穌基督結合一體，她也不能成為救恩的聖事；因為是祂實現了救恩計畫，是祂以其死亡及復活而成為救恩的中保；教會因此被稱為基督的身體，因為她與救恩的中保基督合而為一，基督是頭，教會是身體。此外，正如耶穌受洗之後，天主聖神降在祂身上，表示祂將以聖神的能力實現救恩，教會、基督的身體，也從她的頭分享聖神的能力，聖神在她內，推動救恩的實現，這是教會稱為聖神宮殿的緣故。

這樣看來，教會的根源是天主聖三；我們生活在教會中，不能不經驗到我們分享的是天主聖三的生命，與天主聖三有密切關係。
