Theme Sharing



5th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Be a Fisherman of Men

The theme of today's scripture readings, taken from Isaiah 6:1-8, 1 Corinthians 15:1-11 and Luke 5:1-11, is on vocation and acceptance of God's calling for the sake of the gospel.

We can imagine Luke's joy when he wrote the passage of today's gospel. Now at an important moment in his public ministry, Jesus is gathering his disciples. He is set to mobilize his Church to carry out his mission on earth. He assumes his role of Teacher and, for the first time, entrusts responsibilities of his mission to Simon (later to be called Peter). As this is indeed a solemn moment in the Church's history, Luke describes the event vividly in detail in the gospel.

Simon and his fellow fishermen were all amazed at the miracle on the catch of so many fish. In humble adoration with bended knees, Simon said to Jesus: "Go away from me, Lord, for I am a sinner." What follows is the climax of today's gospel, with Jesus saying to Simon, "From now on, you will be a fisherman of men." In other words, Simon would no longer catch fish and would instead catch people and Church bring them to the established by Christ. Simon promptly accepted his calling to be a "fisherman of men". He and his fellow fishermen left everything and followed Christ.

A similar picture is painted in the first reading on the calling of Isaiah. Isaiah had a vision inside the temple in Jerusalem and, like Simon, he was overwhelmed with fear. He cried out: "Woe is me! I am doomed to die, for I am a man of unclean lips, and I live among a people of unclean lips; yet my eyes have seen

the King, the Lord of hosts!" Then an angel of the Lord touched Isaiah's mouth with a piece of red-hot coal taken from the altar, and cleansed all his guilt. Thereupon, Isaiah accepted God's calling to be his prophet.

God is all-loving and he will never abandon his Church. Even to this day, numerous people receive calling from God who will cleanse them with red-hot coal. Like Isaiah and Simon, these men and women are willing to leave everything behind to follow Christ and be fishermen of people for God.

Jesus energized the apostles with the fish-catching miracle. He is still doing the same for the Church through the Holy Spirit.. No persecution can ever stop the Church from doing its work to proclaim the good news to the ends of the earth. This explains why a lot of men and women today are responding to God's calling: "Whom shall I send?" with the answer: "Here I am, Lord!"; accepting without hesitation to God's invitation to be "fishermen of men".

Pope's February prayer intention: Human Trafficking

Pope Francis on Thursday released a video message accompanying his prayer intention for February, which this month is "Human Trafficking ".

In his prayer intention for the month of February 2019, Pope Francis calls us to pray for a generous welcome of the victims of human trafficking, of enforced prostitution, and of violence.

It has become the custom of Pope Francis to release a video message detailing his prayer intention for each month.

The full text of his intention is below:

Although we try to ignore it, slavery is not something from other times.

Faced with this tragic reality, no one can wash their hands of it without being, in some way, an accomplice to this crime against humanity.

We cannot ignore the fact that there is as much slavery in the world today as there was before, or perhaps more.

Let us pray for a generous welcome of the victims of human trafficking, of enforced prostitution, and of violence.

The Pope's Worldwide Prayer Network of the Apostleship of Prayer developed "The Pope Video" initiative to assist in the worldwide dissemination of monthly intentions of the Holy Father in relation to the challenges facing humanity.

Bible and Its Versions 聖經及其版本

The Bible - Old and New Testaments

It began centuries before Christ. The scribbles, priests, prophets, and poets of Hebrew people kept a record of their history with God, along with their inspired insights and hopes. As time went on, these sacred writings were gathered into three collections known as "the Law", "the Prophets" and "the Writings". Eventually these three collections came to be considered the canon, or the Hebrew Bible.

When the early Christians recorded the life of Jesus and the teachings of the Christian faith, they also wrote in Greek. The earliest writings of the New Testament are the letters of the Apostle Paul. He wrote to people in specific places, but other believers also wanted copies of Paul's teachings. The Gospels soon followed, as well as other letters, exhortations, sermons, and writings. The church put together the collection that most accurately testified to Jesus Christ. By the end of fourth century, the canon of New Testament contained Gospels, Teachings and Letters was recognized.

Early Translations

By the 3rd century BC, Ptolemy II Philadelphus (r. 285–246 BC) hired 72 Jewish for this earliest Greek translation of Hebrew Bible. The Septuagint contained all the books of the Hebrew Bible, plus an extra seven books

The most significant translation of the early church was a Latin version called the Vulgate. A scholar named Jerome spent over twenty years living and studying in Palestine in order to make an official translation of the Hebrew and Greek Scriptures into Latin. The Vulgate eventually became the official text of western Christianity. Vulgate is Latin for "common" or "everyday".

In the fourth century, the Emperor Constantine authorized the creation of fifty copies of the complete Scriptures, and possibly for the first time, the Old and New Testaments came together as one book. The Latin-speaking Roman Empire fell in the fifth century, and tribes such as Vandals, Goths, and Huns invaded Europe. By the time missionaries and soldiers had brought the gospel to the British Isles and translated the Vulgate into the common language of the people.

English Versions

An English version of the entire Bible was produced by John Wycliffe between 1380 and 1382. He translated from Latin to English.

The first authorized Bible in the English language, called the Great Bible, was published at the time of King Henry VIII.

In 1604, King James I of England ordered a new and better translation of the Bible to be made. The "new" Bible was to be translated from the Hebrew and Greek. This is the influential English translation, the King James Version of 1611.

In 16th Century, William (Cardinal) Allen who was forced to leave England established a college in Douay, France, to train Catholic missionary priests for the conversion of England. The translation appeared in two French cities, Douay and Rheims, in 1609-1610. This English version is known as Douay-Rheims. This translation was used by English-speaking Catholics for over 350 years, until the New American Bible replaced it gradually in the early 1970's.

聖經 - 舊約和新約

它開始於基督前幾個世紀。希伯來人的祭司,先知和詩人記錄了從上帝創世,古時猶太人的歷史,法律和先知預言。隨著時間,這些神聖的著作被分為"法律","先知"和"著作"的集合中。最終這個被認為是經典或希伯來聖經。

新約聖經記錄耶穌的生平和其宗徒的言行,以及早期基督教的事件紀錄,是用希臘文寫作。新約聖經最早的著作是使徒保羅的書信,不久之後,福音書以及其他信件,紀錄和著作也隨之而來。

早期翻譯

公元前 3 世紀,Ptolemy II Philadelphus 托勒密二世(統治時期:公元前 285-246)僱傭了 72 名猶太人,來把希伯來聖經翻譯成希臘文。七十士譯本(The Septuagint) 包含希伯來聖經的所有書籍,另外還有七本書。

公元四世紀末,當時的達瑪蘇主教(Pope Damasus)委託他的書記,亦是他的神學顧問、著名的教父和聖經學者耶柔米 Jerome(公元 347-419/20)重新修訂當時的拉丁文聖經。結果,耶柔米花了約二十年時間,除了修訂當時的新約聖經和舊約的次經書卷之外,還從希伯來文聖經(而非《七十士譯本》!)重新翻譯了舊約聖經。為重譯舊約聖經,耶柔米更遠赴伯利恆城苦讀希伯來文;他可謂是早期教會歷史中能掌握希伯來文的教父。耶柔米所翻譯的聖經譯本名為《武加大譯本》(Vulgate),是一千年來在西方教會最廣泛使用的譯本。其拉丁文名稱Vulgata,意思是「通俗」,意即為一般人所使用

在第四世紀,君士坦丁大帝授權創作五十本完整的經文,並且可能是第一次將舊約和新約作為一本書匯集在一起。講拉丁語的羅馬帝國在公元五世紀淪陷,諸如汪達爾人,哥特人和匈奴人等部落入侵歐洲。當傳教士和士兵把福音帶到不列顛群島並將武加大譯本翻譯。

英文翻譯

整本聖經的英文版本由 John Wycliffe 於 1380 年至 1382 年間製作。他將拉丁文譯成英文。

英國第一部授權的聖經稱為"大聖經",是在亨利八世時期出版的。

1604年,英王詹姆斯一世 (King James I) 下令編譯一本新的,更好的聖經譯本。"新"聖經從希伯來語和希臘語中翻譯出來。《英王詹姆斯譯本》於 1611年出版,是英語世界最具影響力的譯本。

16 世紀, William (Cardinal) Allen 被迫離開英國,在法國杜威建立了一所大學,培訓天主教傳教士英語翻譯。翻譯本於 1609 年至 1610 年出現於法國兩個城市 Douay 和 Rheims。這個英文版本被稱為 Douay-Rheims。這個英語譯本於天主教內使用超過 350 年,直到 New American Bible 在 1970 年代早期逐漸取代它。

聖經的分類: 它如同書柜 全部聖經可分為舊約和新約兩大部份:

- 一. 舊約: 包括梅瑟五書、歷史書、先知書、和訓誨文學(智慧書)。
- 1. 梅瑟五書:創世紀、出谷紀、肋末紀、戶籍紀、 申命紀。
- 2. 歷史書: 若蘇厄書、民長紀、盧德傳、撒慕爾紀上、撒慕爾紀下、列王紀上、列王紀下、編年紀上、編年紀下、厄斯德拉上、厄斯德拉下、多俾亞傳、友弟德傳、艾斯德爾傳、瑪加伯上、瑪加伯下。
- 3. 先知書:包括四大先知:依撒意亞、耶肋米亞【耶肋米亞哀歌和巴路克】、厄則克耳、達尼爾;和十二小先知:歐瑟亞、岳厄爾、亞毛斯、亞北底亞、約納、米該亞、納鴻、哈巴谷、索福尼亞、哈蓋、匝加利亞、瑪拉基。
- 4. 訓誨文學:約伯傳、聖詠集、箴言、訓道篇、雅歌、智慧篇、德訓篇。
- 二. 新約: 包括四福音、宗徒大事錄、書信、和默示錄。
- 1. 四福音: 瑪竇福音、馬爾谷福音、路加福音、若望福音。
- 2. 宗徒大事錄。
- 3. 書信:包括保祿的十四封書信和七封公函,共廿一封。
 - 1. 保禄書信: 羅馬人書、格林多前書、格林多後書、迦拉達書、厄弗所書、斐理伯書、哥羅森書、得撒洛尼前書、得撒洛尼後書、弟茂德前書、弟茂德後書、弟鐸書、費肋孟書、希伯來書。
 - 2. 公函: 雅各伯書,伯多祿前書、伯多祿後書、若望一書、若望二書、若望三書、猶達書。
- 4. 默示錄。
- 以上的七十三卷書,就是我們所說的聖經綱目。

主日分享



常年期第五主日

漁人的漁夫

彌撒中的兩篇讀經和福音分別取自依 撒意亞先知書第6章第1到8節,聖 保祿宗徒致格林多人前書第15章第 1到11節(短式:第15章第3到8 以及11節),聖路加福音第5章第 1到11節。福音與讀經一都講一個 聖召的故事。

我們很容易感覺到聖路加在撰寫本主日的福音記載時的內心快樂。耶穌在聚集了祂的門徒之後,要開始在群眾中間履行自己的任務。祂已動員了祂的教會,現在要以群眾老師的身份親自出場。這是一個重要的時刻。在這時刻,聖伯多祿宗徒要從耶穌手中領受祂的使命。聖路加特意佈置了一個隆重的場面,把耶穌的話語記錄得特別莊嚴,來強調這一事件在教會歷史上的重要性。

西滿和他的同伴,見到了捕魚奇跡,都十分驚訝。伯多祿十分謙遜地崇拜了無窮偉大的天主。他謙遜地說:

「主啊!請遠離我吧!因為我是個罪 人哪!」

接著便是本主日彌撒福音記載的頂峰。「從今以後,你要做漁人的漁夫! (你將綱羅的,是人。)」從此,宗徒們拋棄了一切,去跟隨耶穌, 聖伯多祿則領受了他作「漁人的漁夫」的使命。在本主日的彌撒福音中聖路加已經描繪了教會的藍圖。這教會將在聖神降臨那天彰顯出來。

讀經一記載依撒意亞先知蒙召的故事。在耶路撒冷聖殿裡所經驗的一個神視中,看見了天主的聖德。他也像聖伯多祿宗徒一樣,驚恐失色,喊著說:「我有禍了!我命不久矣!因為我是唇舌不潔的人,住在唇舌不潔的人民中間,竟親眼看見君王、萬軍的上主!」跟著天使用一塊火紅的炭,

消除了他的罪孽,派給了他先知的任 務。

今日仍有許多人,接觸了天主的崇高 聖德。天主也用火紅的炭,潔凈他 們;他們也便拋棄了一切,去跟隨基 督,去作漁人的漁夫。

從前耶穌在捕魚的奇蹟中給予宗徒們的生命活力,今日仍在教會內繼續產生作用,歷史上的任何迫害都不能撲滅它。「你要做漁人的漁夫!」這句話在今日的世界上仍舊不斷地響亮著,任何事件或人物都不能削弱它的號召力。


