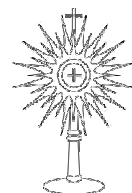

Theme Sharing



6th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Blessed Are You

Who Are Poor

Scripture readings are taken from Jeremiah 17:5-8, 1 Corinthians 15:12 & 16-20 and Luke 6:17 & 20-26.

Today's gospel is on a section of the "Sermon on the Mount" by Jesus. According to Luke, the Beatitudes (i.e. divine blessings on certain virtues) were delivered by Jesus on a level spot in the mountain to a large crowd of people. Compared with the other two synoptic gospels (Matthew and Mark), Luke often records the events of Jesus' ministry at a somewhat different angle. Here Luke only lists four beatitudes, with the curses for being otherwise alongside.

In the first reading, the Lord curses those who trust in mere mortals while blesses those who trust in him. It is obvious that when read with the gospel, the focal message is found in the beatitude "**Blessed are you who are poor**". The "poor", as opposed to the "rich" in the literal sense of the word, denotes a general lack of basic material necessities in life.

Material poverty

is the means, not the end.

In today's gospel, "the poor" refers to those who are suffering from material deprivation. However, as in Matthew's gospel, it carries a deeper meaning and Jesus is really talking about "poverty in spirit". Material poverty, by itself, has no positive attribute. We do not seek to become poor for the sake of poverty. Material poverty is the means, not the end. We seek poverty as the means to release ourselves from the

bondage of material possessions so that we can focus our mind to follow Christ.

Whereas material wealth may be a stumbling block for us to get close to God, material and spiritual poverty helps us to achieve freedom of mind so that we can concentrate on doing God's will.

Cases in point are the hermits living in the wilderness in medieval times and numerous religious people living a consecrated life in modern times. They live a life of abstinence and poverty so that they can devote themselves freely and entirely in serving God.

True poverty requires that we no longer seek or worry about such things as praises, acceptance and status.

"Do not seek places of honor at the synagogues" Luke 11:43

"Instead you should take the lowest place" Luke 14:10

"Blessed are you when people hate you, and when they exclude you, revile you and defame you on account of the Son of Man"

Luke 6:22

So bear in mind that poverty, or material destitution, is a helpful tool for us to gain entry to the Kingdom of God.

"Lord, you give us food from heaven. May we always hunger for the bread of life. Grant this through Christ our Lord. Amen."

ST. VALENTINE, MARTYR ON THE VIA FLAMINIA

The story of Valentine, the Roman priest, dates back to around AD270, during the persecutions of the Emperor Claudius Gothicus. Valentine was well known for his sanctity and the Emperor, who was intrigued by his fame, invited him to the palace. He offered Valentine his friendship and said he should adore the gods. But Valentine stated courageously and firmly that it was a waste of time worshipping the gods since Jesus Christ had brought the only true hope and the promise of a better world. The Emperor was impressed by Valentine's faith and entrusted him to a Roman nobleman named Asterius, whom he ordered to convert Valentine using "mellifluous arguments". Asterius had a daughter who had been blind since the age of two. Valentine prayed over her and the girl regained her sight. Faced with this miracle, Asterius converted to Christianity along with his whole family. When he heard about their conversion, the Emperor Claudius condemned Valentine to be beheaded. The execution took place on the Via Flaminia in Rome. He was buried nearby and soon a church was built there in his honor.

There are too many connections between the stories of the Valentine of Rome and the Valentine of Terni, including their places of martyrdom and burial, for us not to think they are one and the same person. Both give heroic testimonies of faith, both perform a miraculous healing that causes conversions, and both are martyred by beheading on the Via Flaminia in Rome. It was the Benedictine Order that maintained the church of St Valentine in Terni during the Middle Ages and that spread the cult of Valentine's Day in their monasteries in France and England. The tradition of his being patron saint of lovers finds its origin in an ancient English text by Geoffrey Chaucer, according to whom birds start mating on Valentine's Day. In mid-February, in fact, nature begins to awaken from its winter lethargy, so Saint Valentine has become the saint who announces the coming spring – which is why he is sometimes represented holding the sun in his hand.

常年期第六主日

貧窮的人是有福的

彌撒中的兩篇讀經和福音分別取自耶肋米亞先知書第 17 章第 5 到 8 節，聖保祿宗徒致格林多人前書第 15 章第 12 以及 16 到 20 節，聖路加福音第 6 章第 17 到 18 以及 20 到 26 節。

本主日的彌撒福音記載耶穌講的「山中聖訓」。但是，在聖路加福音的記載中，耶穌是在山下平地上，向一大群聚集在那裡的人們發表那篇訓詞的。比較聖瑪竇和聖馬爾谷福音，我們發現其中有許多共同點，但是也有差異處。聖路加福音的特色，是它用有節奏的散文先寫出四種幸福，然後提出四種相反的禍害，來與它們搭配。

本主日彌撒中的讀經一給我們陳列了一個簡單而斷然的對比。其次序與彌撒福音恰好相反。耶肋米亞先知先談可咒罵的--信賴世俗的人，接著才談到可祝福的--信賴上主的人。

在讀經一的對照下，重讀本主日的彌撒福音，我們認為它的重點是在「你們貧窮的人是有福的」這句話上。在這句話中，「貧窮」一詞指物質上的貧乏，正如下文的「富有」也指物質方面的豐富充裕。

在聖路加福音的記載中，耶穌所講的比喻中貧窮也都是指物質財富的缺乏。但是，單憑物質上的貧乏是無濟於事的，必要的是一顆貧窮的心。這就是聖瑪竇福音中所說的「神貧」。

物質貧乏本身並無積極的價值，所以並不為貧窮而追求貧窮，我們不過利用它來擺脫物質財富的纏繞，為能更妥當地追隨基督。換句話說，在聖路加看來，物質上的貧乏是引人達到心靈自由更妥當的途徑。

從前在曠野裡獨修的教父們和今日在各修會中度獻身生活的會士們也持同樣的觀點。他們並不是為苦行而求苦行，為貧窮而求貧窮，而是為藉此擺脫物質方面的束縛，能更自由地去追求真正的價值。

貧窮要做到對人們所給予的尊重無動於心的地步。不要「在會堂裡愛坐上座」（路 11:43），而「應該坐末席」（路 14:10）。「為了人子的緣故，世人仇恨你們、棄絕你們、辱罵你們，認為你們的名字是可惡的，而把它們刪除，你們才是有福的」。

總之，貧窮，物質上的貧乏，是一種為獲得天國生活而採用的苦修功夫。

上主，你以天上的神糧養育我們，恩賜我們充實的生命；求你賜我們時常渴求這恩寵，使我們的人生日趨完滿。亞孟。

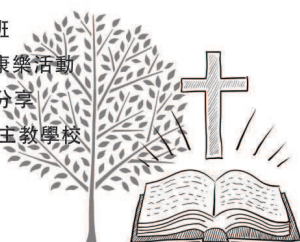

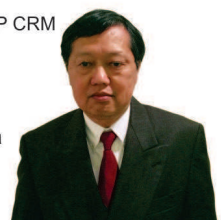
