

Theme Sharing



23rd Sunday of Ordinary Time How God Treats His Friends

The ways of God are mysterious, and our inability to understand them is stressed in today's reading from the book of Wisdom, and were we seriously to consider the message of the other two readings we should perhaps find ourselves asking the question, why should St Paul, having devoted most of his life to the spread of the gospel of Christ, end up a prisoner in chains, with death by violence to follow. Or indeed, why should it be, as stated in the gospel reading, that in order to be a disciple of his Christ says we should carry a cross. Again and again, on our journey through life, we come up against the mystery of suffering, the mystery of the path of the cross which Christ calls us to tread.

One of the saints who suffered all her days, and despite this led a most active life, never allowing herself to be overcome by her troubles, was St Teresa of Avila, foundress of the Discalced Carmelite Sisters. She was an extraordinary person, uniting sublime and mystical holiness with practical good sense and humour. When she heard that her close associate, St John of the Cross, was imprisoned, and being punished as a renegade from the Carmelite Order, she wrote, "God has a terrible way of treating his friends, and in truth he does them no wrong, since that was the way he treated his own Son, Jesus Christ." If Christ then, the all-holy Son of God, submitted to suffering and death, then we his servants cannot expect to be treated any differently from our Master. And this he states for us quite categorically. "Anyone who does not carry his cross and come after me. cannot be my disciple."

But we should not picture God as

being one who takes an unholy delight in seeing his children suffer. If no earthly father worthy of the name would adopt such an attitude, then how much more so our heavenly Father, who sent his Son to show his love for us, to the extent of sacrificing himself for us. This raises the question, why did Christ, in compliance with the Father's will, have to suffer? Indeed, why should any of us have to suffer? We can approach the problem differently by saying that all sufferings, especially those associated with death, are concrete evidence of the mystery of evil, our tendency to upset God's purpose, in other words to commit sin. At the end of the creation story in Genesis (1:31), we are told that "God saw all he had made and indeed it was good." We can therefore say that everything is truly good in so far as it serves God's purpose. But here and now it is obvious that, both physically and morally, the world is not all good. The culprit is sin, which is not only the root of all evil, but tends to blind people's awareness of this fact.



常年期第二十三主日

在今天的福音中, 耶穌很明顯的告訴 那些跟隨祂的人,應該怎樣做才算是 祂的門徒, 這就是跟隨耶穌的條件。 可是, 聽起來, 耶穌的這個條件似乎 有點不對,跟隨祂就應該捨棄房屋、 田地、父母、弟兄姐妹等等, 成為門 徒的要求是:追隨耶穌,不是一件容 易的事情, 為了全心全意侍奉天主, 必須有所犧牲, 甚至是違背家人的期 望。這意味著重大的代價和犧牲,但 卻得不到任何屬世的獎賞或保障。

我可不可以既愛耶穌, 又愛這個花花 世界?甚至在今天的福音中,耶穌 說: 「人到我這裏來,若不愛我勝過 愛自己的父母、妻子、兒女、弟兄、 姊妹和自己的性命,就不能作我的門 徒。」(路 14:26) 這句話曾經引起一 些誤會, 以為耶穌教導人要撇棄自己 的家人。其實, 耶穌的意思並不是叫 我們不要愛家人或愛自己, 而是在優 先順序上, 衪要求我們將衪擺在第 一。如果我們想到祂是生命的主、復 活的主,就不會覺得這樣的要求太過 份了。不過,這樣的吩咐對重視家族 的華人來說, 可不是容易遵守的一件 事。

在我們的信仰生活中,慢慢的,你可 能會發現, 跟隨基督後, 你會犧牲掉 眾人對你的愛戴、友誼、休閒時間、 或寶貝的嗜好。跟隨基督的代價雖然 很高,但其價值又更加的高了。成為 門徒, 是一項永久的投資, 並且會讓 你有意想不到的收益。

我們一生中會面對許多的抉擇。在種 種大小抉擇的背後, 蘊含著一個最基 本的抉擇 —— 我們是否選擇跟從耶 穌?其他的抉擇都是這基本抉擇的表 達與應用。基督徒生活的成敗, 也與 跟從基督的遠近有密切的關係。對我 們來說, 背十字架的含義或許是模糊 的。但對活在羅馬帝國統治下的人來 說,背十字架只有一個清楚的意思-一 被羅馬政府判死刑,且要親自把自

己將要被釘在上面的十字架背往刑 場。而十字架酷刑通常是一種政治和 軍事的懲罰,專門用來對付被視為威

當耶穌借用背十字架來說明跟隨祂的 要求, 衪背後的意思是十分明顯的。 你若要做一個徹底跟隨耶穌的人,需 作好心裡準備, 你將被現存政治、經 濟、軍事和文化力量視為異類和眼中 釘,要被除之而後快。然而,你為了 跟隨基督, 需願意作出任何犧牲, 甚 至賠上性命也不在乎: 十字架是死亡 的記號。一個跟隨主的人,最大的困 難就是自己,自己的生命、利益、性 格、脾氣等等常常成了我們跟隨主、 順服主的阻礙, 所以主要求作門徒的 捨己背十字架來跟隨祂。

主所走的就是一條捨己背十字架的 路,一個真正的基督徒必定會經歷主 耶穌在地上所遇到的各樣的事。保祿 說: 直到如今, 我們還是又飢、又 渴、又赤身露體、又挨打、又沒有一 定的住處(林前4:11)。保祿為 主、為福音的緣故,背十字架、受羞 辱、受鞭打、受逼迫、受苦待, 他心 甘情願走捨己的道路成為我們學習、 效法的榜樣。

下物質而言, 主要作門徒的必須要有 不惜犧牲一切的決心來跟隨祂。 今天的基督徒分兩種, 一種不願為信 仰付任何代價; 另一種明知十字架的 路是一條窄路,但為了信仰、為了主

"撇下一切"的意思並不是單單指撇

不惜犧牲一切, 甚至是自己的生命。 主所要的是第二種人。

願我們大家都能對做基督徒的條件有 很清楚的認識, 都能對主耶穌有很堅 固的信心、對天國永生有很強烈的盼 望。進而,在注重今生的社會潮流 中, 持之以恆地分別為聖、端正態 度、謹慎言行、互相提醒、彼此勉 勵,好好把握飛快流逝的有限時光, 爭做主耶穌真正的門徒、成為真正得 到天國永生的人!

天主的旨意是甚麼? 爲何跟隨主旨是如此困難?

「我們的天父… 願祢的旨意奉行在人間…」

《天主經》我們可唸過多少次?由於非常熟習禱文,我們往往不會慢慢地唸以反思其意義。我們都知道這是耶穌教導門徒及我們如何祈禱的經文 (瑪寶福音 6:9-13)。

耶穌警戒祂的跟隨者不可流於「空洞的言詞」;向天主說無心的話或作瑣碎的祈求,只顧及自己的願望,對天主的聲音充耳不聞 (瑪竇福音 6:5-8)。我們祈禱時,常著重向天主祈求;呈上我們的願望,暗暗冀望天主的滿全!但事實上,天主如此深知我們,祂早已把最好的給了我們;但願我們能夠調低自己的聲音,好去聆聽天主。

甚麼是天主的旨意?為何跟隨天主的旨意如此困難?可能只是我們的自負, 一心相信自己能掌控生命的一切。我們要求保證及把握,但同時我們又深知 這是絕無可能。

在智慧篇中,撒羅滿(King Solomon)祈求智慧,「撒羅滿想及無人能知悉天主的計劃,是由於我們的理解力很薄弱。我們受制於軟弱的肉體。對世事我們已難以理解,又可況是天上的事。正如歷史所顯示,除非天主賦予智慧,我們不能知道天主的計劃」(熱羅尼莫聖經詮釋 517)。的而且確,天主會從「天上差遣聖神」給我們啟示祂的旨意,並引領我們走向它。唯有依靠天主的神,我們才能清除內心的雜亂無章,騰出空間容納天主的旨意。

令我們心靈雜亂無章的究竟是甚麼?財富?名譽?社交媒體?房屋?汽車?家庭?工作?在這一切當中,天主在那裏?我們該如何分清次序?

在路加福音中,路加概述了作門徒的條件和次序:「惱恨自己的性命」;「背著自己的十字架」;「捨棄他的一切所有」(路加福音 14:26,27,33)。耶穌要求我們全心的承諾。幸好我們知道,可以滿懷信心地把自己全交在天主手中,因為其他的事,天主早已照顧好了:耶穌解釋道,「你們的天父原曉得你們需要這一切。你們先該尋求天主的國和它的義德,這一切自會加給你們」(瑪竇福音 6:32-33)。

讓我們祈禱,這一次,慢慢地唸《天主經》並多做反思,堅信天主會供給我們一切,我們只需向天父說:「願祢的旨意奉行」便夠了!
