Theme Sharing



29th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Pray with Persevering Faith The scripture readings dwell on prayers in the Christian life. Prayer draws one to God, and raises one's mind and heart to God. Depending on the circumstances of one's life, the prayer may be expressed in the blessing. of petition. repentance, thanksgiving or giving praise to God. Simply put, the prayer embodies one or more of the above intentions. The four gospels record numerous instances of Jesus at prayers. Jesus also taught his disciples how to pray and explained to them why they need to pray constantly.

In today's parable of the Unjust Judge and the Widow, Jesus tells his disciples that they need to pray at all times without losing heart. The story goes with a poor widow pleading relentlessly to a judge for justice. Although the judge is corrupt and unjust, and fears neither God nor man, he ultimately grants justice to the widow in view of her persistence. Again in the first reading, from Exodus 17:8-13, the Israelites were at war with the Amaleks. In the end, the Israelites won, not because they had a superior army but because of the incessant prayers of Moses to the Lord, symbolized by the raising of his hands towards heaven.

The message from today's scripture readings is clear. If we pray with faith and patience, God will listen to our prayers. He may not give us what we "want", but he will surely give us what we "need". Elsewhere in the gospel, Jesus states in no uncertain terms the effect of prayers: "Ask and you shall receive; seek and you shall find; knock and the door shall be opened to you. Whoever asks receives, whoever seeks finds and whoever knocks will have the A ticket is required for those who

door opened to him." So if we pray with perseverance, and in conformity with God's Will, we can rest assured that our prayers will be answered.

At the end of the parable, Jesus asks: "and yet, when the Son of Man comes, will he find faith on earth?" Evidently, Jesus teaches us that, from apart praying perseverance, we must also have faith in God's Goodness. We have to pray constantly so that we can maintain a lively faith. Then when the journey of our life is over, we can be considered as God's people worthy to receive eternal happiness in his Kingdom.

The Church today encourages us, as did the priests in our childhood days, to pray constantly and say some special prayer(s) to Our Lady before we go to bed each night. In fact, daily recitation of the Hail Mary helps to remind us of the shortness of our life and the certainty of our death. In this beautiful prayer, we ask Our Blessed Mother to intercede for us today and at the end of our life

"Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners, now and at the hour of our death.

Amen."

Wasting the bread of the poor

我們在浪費 窮人的食糧



Pope Francis sends a message to the FAO Director General, Qu Dongyu, for World Food Day, expressing his concern for the "distorted relationship between food and nutrition".

Pope Francis begins his message by referring to the theme for this year's World Food Day: "Our Actions Are Our Future. Healthy Diets for a #ZeroHunger World". The Pope notes that "despite efforts made in recent decades, the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development is yet to be implemented in many parts of the world".

Food wasted or consumed in excess

Pope Francis calls attention to the "distorted relationship between food and nutrition". He cites the fact that while **820 million people suffer from hunger in the world, "almost 700 million are overweight**". He calls it a "cruel, unjust and paradoxical reality" that there is food for everyone and yet not everyone has access to it. The Pope laments the fact that "food is wasted, discarded and consumed in excess, or destined for other purposes than nutrition".

Poor nutrition gives rise to pathologies caused by "excess", says the Pope, giving the examples of "diabetes, cardiovascular diseases and other forms of degenerative diseases", but also by "deficiency", as documented by "an increasing number of deaths from anorexia and bulimia".

By adopting a more "simple and sober lifestyle", continues Pope Francis, we "grow in a fraternal solidarity that seeks the common good and avoids the individualism and egocentrism that serve only to generate hunger and social inequality".

Role of the Family

"Within the family, and thanks to the particular sensitivity and wisdom of women and mothers, we learn how to enjoy the fruits of the earth without abusing it", he writes.

The bread of the poor

"the battle against hunger and malnutrition will not end as long as the logic of the market prevails and profit is sought at any cost". Our first concern should always be the human person, writes the Pope: "We must come to realize that what we are accumulating and wasting is the bread of the poor".

在舉行世界糧食日之際,教宗致函糧農組織總幹事,指出食物已不再被用來維生,而是變成毀滅人的管道。 10月16日是世界糧食日,今年的主題為"行動造就未來,健康飲食實現零饑餓"。在此機會上,教宗致函糧農組 織總幹事屈冬玉。他在信函中寫道,"儘管近幾十年作出很多努力,但 2030 年達到可持續發展的議程仍未在世界 許多地方落實"。

教宗呼籲衆人留意"食物與營養之間遭到扭曲的關係"。他引用一個事實說,**全球有8.2億人挨餓,但是"約有7億人超重"**。他稱這是"殘酷、不公正和自相矛盾的實況"。有足夠的食物供人人享用,然而卻不是每個人都能得到食物。教宗譴責糧食遭到浪費和丟棄,以及過度攝取。

教宗指出,我們需要改變我們的生 活和行為方式, "藉由對我們所獲 得的恩賜心存感激, 並養成節制、 克制、自我控制和互助的精神, 才 能克服飲食失調的問題"。教宗表 示,如果我們度一種更加"簡單和 樸素的生活方式,就能在兄弟般的 團結互助中成長, 尋求公益, 避免 個人主義和利己主義",後者只會 造成"饑餓和社會不平等"。

談到家庭扮演的重要角色時,教宗 指出, "在家庭中, 藉著婦女和母 親的關注和智慧, 我們學會如何享 受大地上的果實而不濫用它"。

教宗在信函最後總結道, "只要市 場邏輯和不惜一切代價尋求利潤的 思維盛行一天, 那麼與饑餓和營養 不良抗爭就不會結束"。我們首先 要關注的應該是人, "我們必須要 意識到, 我們積累和浪費的是窮人 的食糧"。

主日分享



常年期第二十九主日

祈禱是人投靠天主的一種方式,它包 括人生各方面的情况;分開來說,有 祈福的祈禱, 有求情的祈禱, 有悔罪 的祈禱, 有感恩的祈禱, 和讚頌的祈 禱。

本主日彌撒中的福音包括一個「比 喻」和這個比喻的「解釋」。比喻是 講恆心祈禱的效果; 在比喻的解釋 中,耶穌卻加上下面這句話,說:

「但是人子來的時候, 在世上能找到 這樣的信德嗎?」這樣,又把有關祈 禱的教訓,和對世界末日來臨的警惕 聯在一起了。

在本主日彌撒中的讀經一, 內容記述 以色列人和阿瑪肋克人的作戰。在那 次戰爭中以色列人打了勝仗。但是以 色列人之所以得勝, 並不是由於它的 兵力強盛, 而是由於梅瑟所伸開而高 舉的雙手。伸開而高舉的雙手象徵祈 禱。以色列人的那次勝利,是梅瑟恆 久不懈的祈禱的效果。

保祿在讀經二裡也強調信德。他肯定 指出聖經能夠教導人得救, 但為得到 救恩需要通過信仰基督耶穌。

聖經是天主賜給他的子民, 我們眾人 的一個非凡禮物。但這禮物要通過信 德去接受。如果一個沒有信德的人唸 聖經, 聖經就成了死的文字, 不是活 生生的經文:相反的,如果一個人懷 著信德去唸, 那麼聖經就變得生氣盎 然, 為大家都有用, "為教訓人、督 責人、矯正過錯、並為教導人成聖, 都是有益的,它使天主的人得到充分 的準備, 適合做各種善事。"

讀經一和福音中所記載的不義的法官 和寡婦的比喻一樣,都強調了恆心祈 禱的功效。耶穌曾說過:「你們求, 必會給你們: 你們尋找, 就會找到: 你們敲門,就會給你們開。所以,祈 禱的效果是不容置疑的。祈禱而又能 | (Queen's Park

恆心, 當然必定會奏效。不但是恆心 祈禱, 而且也是堅持信德, 更好說是 以恆心祈禱來堅持信德。這樣當天主 收我們的靈魂的時候, 我們將被認作 是屬於耶穌的人。

本主日禮儀給我們提出的兩個教訓, 是相輔相成的: 堅持不懈的祈禱和滿 懷信德祈禱, 是我們同天主個別關係 的基礎。

信德是望德和愛德賴以建立的基礎。 因著信德我們可以在望德與愛德中成 長; 為能經常更好地得到天主的這些 奇妙恩典, 則需要常常祈禱。


