Theme Sharing

Epiphany of Our Lord Christ is the Light of All Peoples)

Today we celebrate the Feast of Epiphany of Our Lord and commemorate Christ as the light of all peoples.

The same scripture passages are used in the readings for all three liturgical years. So what message is it really trying to convey? It is that salvation is for all, not just for the chosen people – the Israelites. In the Hebrew Testament, God promised the Israelites that Jesus would be sent to them as their Saviour. However, when Jesus was born, his own people rejected him; and it was the Gentiles, the “outsiders” from a foreign land, who first came to adore the new-born Messiah.

Today's gospel shows that the entire human family would be the new chosen people in place of the Israelites who had rejected their God in the first place. The first reading prophesizes that all nations will be drawn to God, while the second reading reveals that salvation will come to all peoples. In the language of the Old Testament, the term “all peoples” or “Gentiles” simply means non-Israelites.

As the chosen people, the Israelites worshipped God and accepted God as their Lord and King. On the other hand, all non-Jews or Gentiles were despised and considered as outcasts who knew nothing about the God of Israel. They worshipped man-made idol gods who “have eyes but cannot see, and have ears but cannot hear.” However, it was prophesized that, at some point of time in the future, all peoples would come to know God and worship him as their Lord.

Although Paul was only called as an apostle following Christ's resurrection and ascension into heaven, he was the first to realize that God's plan of salvation would encompass all humankind. So Paul set his mission to preach the gospel to all nations. In today's second reading, he proclaims that salvation is universal: “the Gentiles have become fellow heirs, members of the same body, and sharers in the promise of Christ Jesus through the gospel.”

Brothers and sisters, it was 2000 years ago when, by the light of a star, the Magi from the East were guided all the way to Bethlehem in Judea to pay tribute to infant Jesus. In fact, this is a sign of what is to come at the second Coming of Christ when all peoples will converge on him, and Jesus will be the King of kings and be adored by all. We are now living between the first and second coming of Christ. Just like the Magi, we are also guided by a star – our Mother Church.

The Second Vatican Council document “Lumen Gentium” states that today's Church is the “pilgrim church”, reflecting the light of Christ and symbolizing the budding and beginning of the Kingdom of God on earth. In close union with God, the Church is a sign and tool for unity of the human family. The liturgy of today's mass explains the universality of salvation and affirms the important role of the Church in God's plan. Our Church is the New Jerusalem prophesized by Isaiah and the mystery mentioned by Paul in the second reading. All peoples will gather within the Church to proclaim the glory of God; and through her preaching of the gospel, all peoples are able to enjoy the fruits of salvation in Christ.

The Pastor Comes by Your House

A pastor went out one Saturday afternoon to visit his church members. At one house, it was obvious that someone was home, but nobody came to the door even though the preacher knocked several times. Finally, the preacher took out his card, wrote out 'Revelation 3:20' on the back of it, and stuck it in the door:

"Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in to him and dine with him, and he with me."

- Revelation 3:20

The next morning, the card turned up in the collection plate. Below the preacher's message was written the following notation:

"I heard your voice in the garden, and I was afraid because I was naked; and I hid myself."

- Genesis 3:10

EPIPHANY 主顯節

Epiphany is a solemnity or major feast celebrated on 6th January, though – since the reform of the liturgical calendar – it is now marked by many Catholic churches on the Sunday between the 2nd and 8th January, where 6th January is not a holy day of obligation.

Nowadays in the West the feast goes by the name Epiphany and celebrates the visit of the Magi and while in the East it is called Theophany and celebrates the appearance of God at the Baptism of Jesus.

The word epiphany was used in Greek religion to indicate the appearance or manifestation of a god or goddess in human form along with the suggestion that the person or persons who had the epiphany would be delivered from danger and/or their enemies defeated. Theophany is a less frequently used word meaning the same thing. In the New Testament epiphany is used to refer to both the first and the final coming of Jesus (Titus 2:11, 13). The word then came to be used of the miracles of Jesus as manifesting divine power.

As a Christian celebration on 6th January the feast is first mentioned by Clement of Alexandria around 215 AD. He mentions the Basilidians, a gnostic Christian group, commemorating the baptism of Jesus on that day (PG 8:885).

A pagan feast of the sun-god was already celebrated in Egypt for the winter solstice on 6th January. On the previous night, the pagans of Alexandria commemorated the birth of their god Aeon, supposedly born of a virgin. They also believed that on this night the waters of rivers, especially the Nile, acquired miraculous powers and even turned into wine. It is possible that such beliefs could have prompted the addition of the themes of the birth of Jesus and the miracle of Cana to the Christian feast.

But by the fourth century AD the feast in the East had acquired a combination of four themes – Jesus' birth, his baptism, the miracle of Cana and the coming of the Magi. St Epiphanius, bishop of Salamis in Cyprus (315-402) says that 6th January is “the day of Jesus' birth, that is, of his epiphany” (PG 41:935-940), but he also mentions the miracle of Cana and the Magi. Probably because of the multivalency of the term “epiphany”, it easily gathered a multiplicity of themes.

主顯節原本是東方教會慶祝耶穌誕生的節日。在古代的思想脈絡中「主顯」(Epiphaneia)一詞的希臘文原意是：一位神出現，使人肉眼可以看見；或是一位被當作神崇拜的皇帝，到他王國的某一城市拜訪，使當地的居民能看見他。關於主顯節最早的記載，可以回溯到第三世紀。當時有些諾斯底派的人在一月六日慶祝「耶穌受洗節」，並主張耶穌在受洗時才真的誕生為天主子。埃及亞歷山大城的 Clemens 為了保護教會信仰，駁斥諾斯底派的這個錯誤教導，呼籲教會一起慶祝主顯節，因而在東方教會形成慶祝耶穌誕生的節日。至於教會選定於一月六日慶祝這個節日的原因，則可能是由於當時的外教人在這一天慶祝「時間之神」的生日；以一個教會的節日來取代在教外流行的民俗或宗教慶節，是古老教會常見的現象，也是最早期的「本位化」的嘗試。

這個原本是東方教會慶祝「耶穌誕生」的節日，很早便和「耶穌受洗」連結在一起，後來又融入耶穌在加納「變水為酒」的紀念。由第四世紀開始，羅馬天主教會便固定在十二月二十五日慶祝耶穌聖誕，並在一月六日慶祝主顯節，紀念耶穌把自己顯示給世人的三個核心事件：賢士來朝、耶穌受洗、變水為酒。

禮儀年不論甲、乙或丙年主顯節的福音選讀，都是瑪竇敘述的「賢士來朝」的故事（瑪二 1-12）。這是一個戲劇性非常豐富的故事，可以分許多不同的場景：賢士來到耶路撒冷（1-2）、和黑落德王相見（3-6）、黑落德王的指示（7-8）、異星的導引（9-10）朝 拜嬰兒（11）、賢士返鄉（12）。

主日分享



主顯節-基督是萬民之光

我們今天慶祝主顯節，即「三王來朝瞻禮」。在這瞻禮，教會紀念耶穌是「萬民之光」。

主顯節對我們基督信徒來說，是一個意義非常重大的節日。我們基督信徒，一般不是來自猶太民族，而是來自外邦。對外邦人，天主沒有做許諾。主顯節則顯示了天主也願意召叫所有的外邦人信仰基督，好得到救援。因此，這個節日具有非常深刻的意義。

瑪竇所記載的事令人驚訝。一些賢士從東方來到耶路撒冷，來朝拜新誕生的猶太君王。他們都是星象學家，他們看到他的星出現在天上，於是馴服地啟程前來朝拜他。不過他們所見到的那顆星沒有指示出新生王誕生的確切地方，因此，他們去了耶路撒冷，尋找經書上所提供的其他有關資料。賢士們詢問默西亞誕生的地方，他們從耶路撒冷的大司祭和經師們那裏得知：「在猶大的白冷，因為先知（米該亞）曾這樣記載：『你，猶大地白冷啊！你在猶大的郡邑中，決不是最小的，因為將由你出來一位領袖，他將牧養我的百姓以色列。』」有了這個資料，賢士們便能夠繼續他們的旅程。

在這裏，我們可以看到不同的人物所表現出的不同態度。賢士們原是在遙遠的地方，卻不辭辛苦離鄉背井，長途跋涉去尋找新誕生的猶太君王。而那些大司祭和經師們雖然有天主的啟示，卻一動也不動，他們雖然把啟示傳給了別人，自己卻不去朝拜默西亞。

黑落德的態度更差。當時，他管轄整個猶大和加里肋亞地區，是一個有才幹的人，但野心非常大。他為了保障

自己的權力，不惜殺死所有的敵對者，甚至還殺了一些自己的親人。黑落德只把新生的猶太王看作是影響自己權力的危險，因此他假裝地向賢士們說：「你們去仔細尋訪嬰孩，幾時找到了，給我報信，好讓我也去朝拜他。」其實，他有意要殺死這可能的敵人。

賢士們在星星的指引下，來到了白冷，並進入了屋內，看見嬰兒和祂的母親瑪利亞，便俯伏朝拜了祂。賢士們的這個舉動具有先知性的意義，因為向人指出了這嬰兒是天主的聖子，也預報了將有大量的人從外邦前來朝拜主基督。

賢士們不僅前來朝拜，還帶來了貴重的禮物，就是：黃金、乳香和沒藥。這三樣禮物具有象徵性的意義，黃金代表了耶穌的王權，乳香代表了耶穌的天主性，沒藥則代表了祂會死亡的人性。

以後，賢士們從另一條路返回他們的家鄉，因為他們在夢中得到指示，要他們不要回黑落德那裏。兩篇讀經從兩方面強調耶穌救世工程的普遍性。讀經一預言世界各國都要崇拜天主；讀經二聲明各國人民都要獲得救恩。

聖保祿宗徒是耶穌復活後才蒙召的宗徒。他最早明白耶穌救世工程的普遍性。他以向萬民宣揚福音為自己的職務，他主張外邦人在基督內與猶太人同為繼承人，同為一體，同為恩許的分享人。

其實，天主一開始便向人表示，祂的計畫是為所有的民族的。祂曾這樣對亞巴郎說：「萬民都要因你獲得祝福。」（創 12, 3）不過，關於這一點，舊約中說得比較含蓄，因此不太為人注意，人們對其中的意義也不完全瞭解。

保祿卻瞭解到那是給予萬民的啟示，這啟示帶領所有的人與天主親密結合。這是一件美妙的事，一定要令我

們興奮的！我們蒙召受天主恩許的祝福，那些似乎是為選民所保留的，天主也要以無限的慷慨通傳給我們。
