Theme Sharing



6th Sunday in Ordinary Time Making good choices

The first reading suggests the importance of human choice as a theme for a homily. It has been said that we do not make big choices, only a whole series of little ones. The fundamental choice in life according to our first reading is that between fire and water, life and death. That fundamental choice finds concrete expression in the multiple choices of daily life. Each day we try to make choices which are life-giving both for ourselves and others. In the complexities of daily living it is not always easy to discover the way which leads to life. In retrospect, we often realise that we have made bad choices, even though, at the time, we acted in good faith. Both the first and second readings speak about the wisdom of God. We need that wisdom to choose well, a wisdom which comes through the Spirit. Paul reminds us that "the Spirit reaches the depths of everything, even the depths of God." It is the Spirit who enables us to choose "in depth," to make the kind of choices which are most in tune with what is deepest in us and, therefore more life-giving.

Choices which come from what is deepest and best in us will be life-giving, both for ourselves and others. In the gospel reading, Jesus proposes a virtue which goes deeper than that of the scribes and Pharisees, a virtue in depth, from the heart. If our depths are sound, if the heart is good, then the choices which come from the heart will be good. The converse is also true. If we harbour bitterness in our heart towards someone, we will inevitably make choices which damage and hurt them. If we cultivate envy in our heart towards someone, we will tend to make choices which devalue them. Beyond our behaviour lie our choices and beyond them lies the heart in which our choices are rooted. Only the Spirit who reaches the depths of God can really reach our own depths. It is the Spirit who renews and transforms our heart. "God has poured out his love into

our hearts by the Holy Spirit, whom he has given us" (Rom 5:5.) If we keep on opening our hearts to the Spirit of God's love they will be recreated in his love. Then our choices will be rooted in love and will have something of the life-giving quality of Jesus himself.

Fasting and Abstinence

1. Among Catholics, fasting is a reduction in the normal amount of food consumption per day: one regular meal plus two other smaller meals without the provision of snacks during the Holy Days of observation.

2. Among Catholics, abstinence is the omission of meat and other meat products, except fish, in the diet during the Holy Days of observation.

3. Abstinence is practiced by a wider age group of Catholic individuals 14 and up as opposed to fasting which is practiced by Catholics aged 18 to 59.

Lent Called a Time to Strip Away Masks

It Is a Season for Truth

Lent is a good time for self-discovery -- a season to live "without masks."

A pastor of souls has a special role, since people come to him "without masks," in their truth, without hiding behind the role they have in society.

Lent should be lived in this spirit. It is a time for presenting ourselves to God without masks, to try to put our relationship with him back at the center of each of our lives and to simplify our interests and words, returning them to what is truly important.

The spokesman recalled how on Ash Wednesday, Jesus is in the depths of our heart. Our relationship with him is present even when we speak and act in our professional duties. ... This relationship sometimes becomes explicit prayer."

And in his Lenten message, Father Lombardi recalled the value of fasting, inviting the faithful to find appropriate forms for it in daily life, as an exercise of freeing ourselves from attachment to ourselves to open ourselves to the love of God and charity in solidarity with others.

"Thus," Father Lombardi concluded, "this is a time to rediscover the right place for

God and attention to others with the help of simple concrete and daily gestures: prayer, fasting, almsgiving. It is a time to rediscover ourselves too and our truth, without masks. Let us not miss these opportunities!" Father Lombardi





主日分享



常年期第六主日

繼常年期第四主日福音選讀的真福八端，以及第五主日鹽與光的比喻之後，接下來的兩個主日，我們恭聽主耶穌如何以新的精神成全舊的法律。

「即使天地過去了，一撇或一劃也絕不會從法律上過去，必待一切完成。所以，誰若廢除這些誠命中最小的一條，也這樣教訓人，在天國裡，他將稱為最小的；但誰若實行，也這樣教訓人，這人在天國裡將稱為大的。」（瑪 5:18-19）主耶穌強調，祂絕不是來廢除或取代法律，而是教導民衆體現法律的真精神——天主的誠命，藉以成全法律。祂超越經師和法利塞人，是真正具有權威的法律詮釋者。瑪 5:21-48，聖史瑪竇以六組「對仗」，即「你們一向聽說過……，我卻對你們說……」的句型，引入誠命的真精神。本主日探討前四個主題：憤怒、姦淫、休妻和發誓，不可報復和愛仇的教導，留待下個主日聆聽。

天主頒給梅瑟「不可殺人」的誠命。耶穌要求門徒在關係還未惡化到殺人之前，就要消除憤怒，努力和解。耶穌以三個例證，明確指出實行的方向。其一，「誰若向自己的弟兄說『傻子』，就要受議會的裁判，誰若說『瘋子』，就要受火獄的罰」（22），意思是要避免互相侮辱。其二，在獻祭之前，必須先去跟兄弟姊妹們和好（23-24）。其三，「當你和你的對頭還在路上，趕快與他和解，免得對頭把你交給判官，判官交給差役，把你投在獄裡」（25），是警告不要讓衝突加深；讓憤怒醞釀滋長，最後闖下大禍的人，將要接受天主的審判。如同憤怒導致殺人，貪戀女色的眼神，是姦淫的前奏。關於「不可姦淫」的誠命，耶穌的教導超越行為的層面，要求的是內心的潔淨。十誡禁止的不祇是姦淫，還包含了貪戀他人的配偶和財產。「若是你的右眼使你跌倒，剜出它來，從你身上扔掉，因為喪失你一個肢體，比你全身投入地獄裡，為你更好」（29），主耶穌以放

縱貪慾的下場——地獄的永罰，告誡門徒們心思要純潔，不要貪戀非份的人、事、物。

31-32 節，耶穌禁止人休妻，但除了受姦污、犯姦淫的理由之外，沒有更進一步的說明。瑪 19:1-12 提出了耶穌關於不准休妻的教導：婚姻是天作之合，夫妻雙方結為一體，因此天主所結合的，人不可拆散；而梅瑟准許休妻，祇是因為民衆心硬，不能以此為休妻背書，忽略天主的教導。

關於發誓，誠命說：「不要奉我的名妄發虛誓，而褻瀆你天主的名字」（肋 19:12），但耶穌的教導是「總不可發誓」，因為基督徒之間的關係當真誠、透明，所以不需要以發誓，讓他人相信自身言語的可信度。「你們的話該當是：是就說是，非就說非」（37），這句話是基督徒光明磊落、心中無欺詐的具體寫照。

天主賜下理智，無非是要人探究天主的奧秘，但可惜「今世的智慧」並不如此，否則就不會將基督釘在十字架上了（參閱：讀經二，格前 2:6-10）。今世的智慧，傾向於鞏固自身的利益，隱藏行為背後真正的意圖，為自己的惡行合理化；甚至不惜曲解上主的話語，刻意忽略誠命的真義。因此，耶穌闡明誠命真正的精神，以成全法律，彰顯了天主奧秘的智慧。讀經一上說，「生死善惡，都在人面前；人願意那樣，就賜給他那樣」（德 15:18），又說：「祂從未吩咐人作惡，祂從未准許人犯罪。」（21）讓我們隨從聖神的推動，在福音真光的引導下，走上生命之道。

反省與行動：

- 1.我如何化解憤怒和仇恨，與兄弟姊妹和好？
- 2.我努力保持心思的純潔，不貪戀世俗的人、事、物，看重天主結合的婚姻嗎？
- 3.我是否言行一致，為人真誠正直，遵行天主誠命的真精神？

大齋：教會要求年齡已滿十八至五十九歲的教友在每年的聖灰禮儀及聖週內星期五紀念基督聖死日，應守小齋外，還要守大齋，即在那兩天只可飽食一餐，其他兩餐只可進食少許食物，其餘時間可飲流質飲品，但不能進食其他食物（藥物除外）。

四旬期苦路善功

在四旬期內二月二十八日（星期五）開始，按教會傳統，將舉行苦路善功，以紀念主基督為拯救人類所受的苦難聖死。

聖言反思

四旬期

除去面具

四旬期是幫助我們探索我們自己是誰的時期：哲學家帕斯卡爾說過：“世界分成兩種人：認為自己是罪人的義人和認為自己是義人的罪人。”在現今社會，教會建議我們走改過遷善的道路，除去外表，重新發現生命的本質：愛天主和愛近人。

靈魂牧人的任務很特別，因為人們在他面前“不戴防護面具”，揭露他們的真相，不以在社會中扮演的角色來隱藏或保護自己。如果宣講信德的人用自己生活的經歷來宣講，用純樸的方式來宣講，而不用淵博的學問使它過於沉重，對今天男男女女的宣講才會有效力。

四旬期是要本著這個精神來渡過。這段時期是要除去防護面具，來到天主面前，重新把與他的關係放在我們每個人生命的中心，簡化我們的行為和語言，把它們引向確實重要的方向上。耶穌在我們的心底。同祂的關係即使我們按照自己的職業本分說話、行動時，也存在著…這種關係逐漸也變成了明確的祈禱。”在四旬期文告中他提醒我們守齋的價值，邀請我們在日常生活中重新發現它的適當形式，把它作為擺脫我們私慾偏情的一種操練，好使自己向天主的愛和關懷他人的愛德開放。

可以說，這是一段重新找到天主的正確位置和關注他人的時期，經由祈禱、刻苦、行哀矜這些日常具體簡單舉動的幫助。也是一段重新發現我們自己和我們的真相，除去防護面具的時期。我們不可失去這個機會。

靈修小故事



如果我不大聲……

二十世紀初，俄羅斯帝國境內一個小村落裡，住著一個猶太小男孩。那時候，沙皇的軍隊——哥薩克人，正在各地對少數民族的猶太人進行大規模的迫害。每天市集上熱鬧時，全村的人都聚集在大廣場上交易買賣，哥薩克人就會在這個時候，騎著高大驃悍的馬來到市集上，打翻猶太人的貨物、商品，接著宣佈沙皇限制猶太人自由的最新敕令，然後騎著馬揚長而去。

小男孩和祖父的感情非常親密，他的祖父正好是這個村子裡的老教士。村子裡的猶太人都相信，他們的教士和猶太人的祖先亞伯拉罕或摩西一樣睿智。小男孩每天都會陪祖父從他們簡樸的家散步到集市去。哥薩克騎兵總是揮鞭而至，掀起漫天塵土，宣讀當天的事物命令：“今天起，任何猶太人購買馬鈴薯，一次不得超過五個。”或是：“沙皇有令，所有猶太人必須將他們最好的牛立刻賣給國家。”

每天，同樣的故事不斷重演——老教士和其他人一起聽著沙皇的敕令，然後他向那些哥薩克人揮舞著他的拐杖，大聲叫道：“我抗議！我抗議！”然後其中一個哥薩克人就會騎著馬過來，用馬鞭狠狠地抽向老教士，臨走之前還要吼一聲：“閉嘴，你這老蠢貨！”老教士捱不住鞭子，就會倒在地上，他的教徒們會沖過去扶他起來，幫他拍掉衣服上的泥土，然後他的小孫子再攜著他回家。

日復一日，月復一月，小男孩驚悚地看著這一幕再三重演。終於他再也忍不住了，有一天，他送滿身烏泥的祖父從集市回家時，小男孩鼓起了勇氣問：“親愛的老教士，”小男孩的聲音帶著點微微的顫抖：“您明知道那些士兵一定會打您，為什麼還要每天在他們面前抗議沙皇呢？您為什麼不能保持沉默呢？”

老教士對孫子慈祥地笑道：“因為明知是錯的事情，如果我不大聲抗議，我就會漸漸和他們一樣了……。”


