Theme Sharing



Baptism of the Lord (First Sunday in Ordinary Time)

Today is the Sunday following the Epiphany of our Lord, and the first Sunday in Ordinary Time in Year A of the liturgical 3-year cycle. We celebrate the Feast of Baptism of our Lord, and commemorate Jesus' baptism at River Jordan. According to the Fathers of the early Church, this event has threefold meaning. Firstly, God the Father reveals himself and proclaims Jesus as his Son by saying, "This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased." Secondly, the Holy Spirit, in the form of a dove, descends upon Jesus signifying the anointing of Christ to begin his mission as our Saviour. Thirdly, by receiving baptism from John, Jesus shows his solidarity with the sinful humanity, and confirms baptism by water as a sin-cleansing ritual and the means to obtain forgiveness of our sins.

In the first reading, Jesus is portrayed as "Servant of the Lord". In the book of Isaiah, this is the title given to the Messiah: "I have put my spirit upon him; and I have given you as a covenant to the people, a light to the nations, to open the eyes of the blind, to free captives from prison and those living in darkness from the dungeon."

The second reading is on Peter's speech to those assembled in the house of Cornelius, the Roman centurion, immediately prior to his baptism. Peter said it was now clear to him that God intended salvation for all. He declared Jesus as the Messiah and explained how Jesus so carried out his mission to save all men.

One may ask why Jesus in today's gospel insisted to be baptized by John. In reply to John's query, Jesus simply said, "It is proper for us in this way to fulfill God's Will." So exactly what does this mean? According to Hong Kong Biblical Institute, Jesus was sinless and there would be no need for him to get baptized. Regardless, he still received baptism from John for the sole purpose

of fulfilling the Will of his Father. His baptism was part of God's plan of salvation. Through baptism, Jesus identified himself as part of the human race, dwelling among sinners in order to save them. If Jesus, who is God, associates with sinners, then how should we act to fulfill the Will of God? Make no mistake about it: we must acknowledge our sinfulness, have true repentance for our sins, follow the teachings of the Church founded by Christ and, with humility, accept our salvation from our Lord through the guidance of the Church.

We know well that we Christians are also part of the sinful and fallen human race. By our own power and account, we are never able to please God and secure our own salvation. Jesus is the beloved Son of God. It is only through Christ and our total dependence on him that we can expect mercy and compassion from God. And the best way of showing our submission to Christ is to follow the teachings of the Church founded by him. We are then able to obtain in his holy Church the salvation brought to us by Christ.

The Power Of Compassion

Francis Schaeffer, author and Christian apologist, struggled to spell words correctly because of dyslexia. At the college he attended, spelling errors lowered the grade on all written assignments. During his first year, a professor told Schaeffer, "This is the best philosophy paper I've ever read, but it's the worst spelling. What am I going to do? I can't pass you."

Francis replied, "Sir, I could never spell. Could you please just read what I'm saying and not worry about the spelling?"

After a long pause, the professor replied, "You know, Mr. Schaeffer, I think we'll do that." His wise, compassionate response encouraged a gifted young man who would later help many of the searching generation during the 1960s and 70s to find their way to faith in Christ.

Isaiah said of the promised Messiah, "A bruised reed He will not break, and smoking flax He will not quench; He will bring forth justice for truth" (Isa. 42:3).


The image is of a gentle, yet powerful Person who sets prisoners free and encourages those who are fainthearted and tempted to despair.

Jesus came to free us from sin, not to condemn us for our condition. Today, He offers salvation and encouragement to all who turn to Him.





主受洗節

上主的僕人

(常年期首主日)

今年是教會禮儀年曆上的甲年，常年期的主日彌撒福音一般取自聖瑪竇。本主日是主顯節後的主日，我們舉行主受洗節，紀念耶穌在約旦河的受洗。據教父們的解釋，耶穌在約旦河從若翰手中受洗的事件，具有三種深層的意義。第一、在這事件中天主聖父顯示了自己，並且啓示耶穌為祂的聖子。祂說：這是我的愛子，我所喜悅的。第二、天主聖神以鴿子的形像降在耶穌身上，意味著給祂傅油，派遣祂去執行救世主的職務。第三、耶穌本人由若翰手中受洗，表示祂與有罪的人類認同，並且以水作為洗滌罪過、獲得罪赦的標記。

本主日的讀經一把耶穌比作「上主的僕人」。在依撒意亞先知書中，「上主的僕人」是默西亞的稱呼。據依撒意亞先知的講解，天主要在默西亞身上傾注祂的神，要藉著祂跟世人立約，使祂成為萬民之光。祂要開啓盲人的眼睛，把被囚禁的人領出監牢，使黑暗中的人得見光明。

讀經二記述聖伯多祿宗徒給外邦人科爾乃略付洗前的講話。在這篇講話中，宗徒之長聖伯多祿表示，他終於明白了天主要所有的人都得救的道理。他宣佈耶穌是默西亞，並說明耶穌怎樣執行了祂作默西亞的使命，使萬民獲得救恩。

在本主日的彌撒福音裏耶穌為什麼要堅持受洗呢？耶穌說：這是為了「完全履行天主的旨意。」

「完全履行天主的旨意。」這句話值得我們特別注意。香港天主教聖經學會編寫的《清泉掬水》解釋它的意義說：耶穌是無罪的，本來不須受洗。祂所以要受洗，純粹是為了滿全祂父親的計劃。祂的受洗是這計劃的一部分。藉著受洗祂與人類打成一片，做了罪人的一份子！目的是要拯救世人。接著，《清泉掬水》提出一個問題說：耶穌就是與罪人打成一片的天

主。那麼，我們應怎樣做，來完全履行天主的旨意呢？無疑的，我們也應投入罪人的行列。那就是說，應該悔改，信奉耶穌所創立的教會，謙遜地從教會手中接受耶穌給我們帶來的救恩。

原來，我們基督信徒都知道我們是有罪的人類的一部分。憑我們自己的能力，我們無法博得天主的歡心。耶穌是天主所喜悅的愛子。我們依賴耶穌，才能蒙受天主的愛憐。信奉教會是我們依賴耶穌的具體表現。我們在教會內領受耶穌給我們帶來的救恩。

心靈小品**耶穌會神父的十二句話**

- 1.別憂慮那麼多，那是沒有用的。
- 2.要做聖人，就是要做你自己。停止扮演任何人，只要好好地做好你自己，這會讓你避免許多的痛心疾首。
- 3.沒有「最好」的祈禱法則，正如沒有金科玉律令我們結交一位朋友，對你來說，最有效的方式就是「最好」...
- 4.記住三件事，能夠幫你省卻不少煩惱：你，不是天主；這裡，不是天堂；行爲，不要犯渾。
- 5.你心底裡最深處、最真心的渴求，就是天主對你的渴求。反過來亦然。好好聆聽。跟隨他。
- 6.在你心中，早已有一個概念——「最理想的我」是個怎樣的人。你就當自己是「那個人」去生活，你就會成爲那個人——靠著天主的恩寵。
- 7.不要太擔心「最壞的事」如果發生會怎樣怎樣，就算那事真的發生了，天主還是與你一起，你自會感覺到。真的。
- 8.你不能夠強迫任何人同意你、誇獎你、仰慕你、喜歡你，甚至愛你。不要枉費心機！
- 9.當我們跟別人比較，我們通常錯誤地幻想別人的生活，我們現實的生活也就輸掉了——即是說：人比人，只會沮喪。
- 10.就算你終於明白何謂對的事，何謂基督徒應該做的事，要生活出來還是會很困難。無論如何還是要生活出來。
- 11.七句要常常說的話：我愛你！多謝你！天主，多謝你！寬恕我吧！我爲

你高興！爲什麼不？好！

12.想要平安、喜樂，先要祈求天主，在一切阻礙著你去愛、去憐憫的事情中，釋放你、讓你自由。

靈修小故事**祝福滿滿**

每天在上下班的路上，我都有不少時間，可以讀一讀貼在前方車子保險桿上的標語。有的語氣傲慢，有的充滿了智慧，還有的簡直令人反感。然而，最近我看到的一張貼在車尾的標語，卻讓我們心自問：自己的人生態度到底如何。這貼紙寫著：「有福到無可抱怨。」

我必須坦白地承認，當我深思這句話時，心裡感到愧疚。我發現自己常常在事與願違時哀怨感嘆，卻未專注於天父已經賜給我的美好恩典。那天讀到的那句簡短信息，讓我重新立志，願意更加主動並一心向上主獻上感恩。因爲我的上主一直以來都很恩待我，這些恩惠不僅止於我所能數算的，還有更多是我所不能數算的。聖詠 107 篇糾正人們缺乏感恩的心態。聖詠的作者（許多人認爲是達味王），四次如此呼籲：「但願人因上主的慈愛和祂向人所行的奇事，都稱讚祂（8、15、21、31 節）。他勸勉那些不知感恩、逐漸冷淡的人要回轉。因爲即使在最糟的時刻，我們仍有許多可以感謝的。願我們學習爲著上主的慈愛而感謝祂！

主的恩典，樣樣都要數，主的作爲都要記清楚，主的恩典，樣樣都要數，必能叫你驚訝主奇妙看顧。當常存感恩之心，別等到擁有更多才感恩。

知多一點點**基督徒的真福**

1.對天主召人享受真福，新約用了許多說法，爲標示此真福的特色：天國的臨近；看見天主：「心裡潔淨的人是有福的，因爲他們要看見天主」（瑪 5:8）；

進入主人的福樂；進入天主的安息（希 4:7-11）：在那裡，我們將安息，我們將看見；我們將看見，我們將愛慕；我們將愛慕，我們將頌揚。看，這將是沒有終結的終結。除了抵達沒有終結的王國，我們能有別的終結嗎？

2.因爲天主把我們安置在世界上，是爲了認識祂，事奉祂，愛慕祂，因此而抵達樂園。真福使我們分享天主的性體（伯後 1:4）和永生。得到了永生，人便進入基督的光榮和天主聖三生命的福樂。

3.這樣的真福超越人的理解和人自身的能力。真福是天主無條件賞賜的恩典。因此人稱真福是超性的，猶如稱那準備人進入天主福樂的恩寵是超性的一樣。

「心裡潔淨的人是有福的，因爲他們要看見天主」。固然，天主的偉大和祂神妙無比的榮耀，「誰也不能見到天主而仍然活著」，因爲父是不可捉摸的；但天主因祂對人的慈愛、寬容及全能，祂竟恩賜敬愛祂的人得以享見祂；因爲「在人所不能的，在天主卻是可能的」。

4.預許的真福使我們正視決定性的倫理抉擇。真福邀請我們清洗我們的心靈，滌除不良的本能，以求愛天主在萬有之上。真福教導我們真正的幸福不在財富或安逸，不在人間的光榮或權勢，不在任何人的事業，縱使非常有用，如：學術、科技、藝術，也不在任何受造之物，而只在萬善、諸愛之源的天主：

財富是今日偉大的神明；對它，芸芸衆生，大批人群，本能地叩首膜拜。人們以富貴來衡量幸福，甚至也以富貴來釐定尊卑。……這一切乃出自一個信念，就是財富能成就一切。於是財富成了今日的一個偶像，另一個偶像便是聲譽。……所謂聲譽，就是名滿天下，稱譽世界（也可以稱爲新聞人物），已被認同爲善的化身，善的至尊，也成了真正崇拜的對象。

5.天主十誡、山中聖訓、宗徒的傳授，都給我們描繪了導向天國的道路。我們以每天的行爲，藉著聖神的恩寵，逐步努力前進。又藉著基督聖言的灌溉，在教會內，爲了天主的光榮，慢慢地結出果實。




